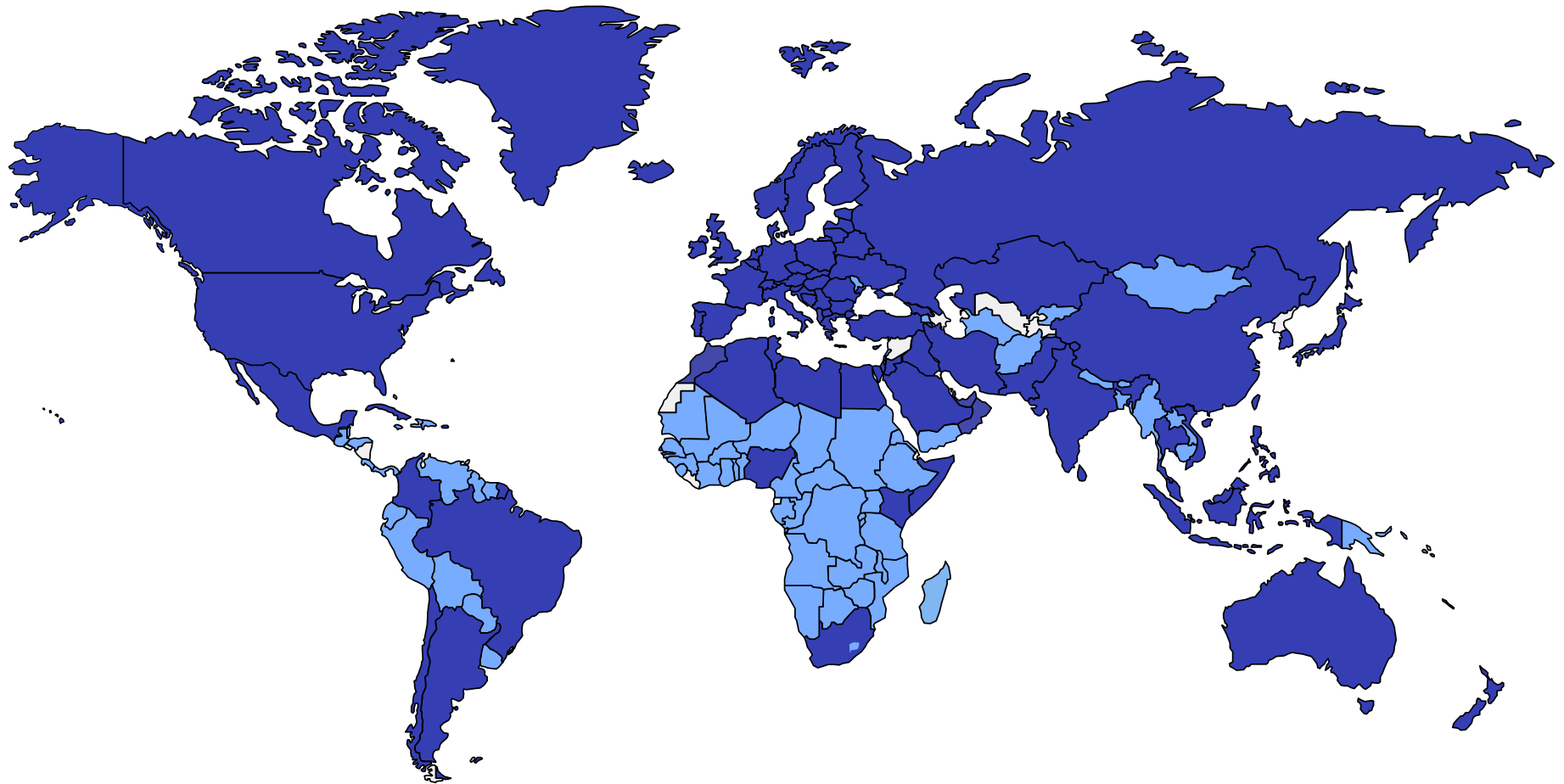

New edition of ISO/IEC Directives, Part 1 – Procedures for the technical work ([AC/13/2009](#))

- **Seventh edition issued in 2009-04**
- **Major changes:**
 - additional recommendations on the formulation of scopes of TCs and SCs
 - expanded clause on chairmen's and secretariat's responsibilities
 - adopted Strategic Business Plan (SBP) – to replace Strategic Policy Statement (SPS)
 - increased flexibility at committee stage (CD) – commenting period 2, 3 or 4 months



New edition of ISO/IEC Directives Supplement – Procedures specific to IEC ([AC/5/2010](#), [AC/8/2010](#))

- Fifth edition issued in 2010-01
- Major changes:
 - maintenance procedures reviewed
 - inclusion of the use of “Collaboration tools” for meeting documents at TC meetings, thus eliminating the need for “green documents”
 - addition of IEC TC 100’s specific procedures and organizational structures

Review and maintenance procedures : Major changes ([AC/6/2010](#))

- “Stability period” and “Stability date” replace “Maintenance cycle” and “Maintenance result date”
- Extended the minimum stability period from 2 to 3 years
- FormMCR replaced by FormRR (review report) recording TC/SC decisions
- Allocating decision making to P-members
- TCs/SCs may advance review / stability dates, where there is an urgent need without requesting SMB approval



Review and maintenance procedures: Recommended procedures ([AC/6/2010](#), [FAQ](#))

- Circulate a DC document in advance of the meeting requesting P-members' comments on usage of publications up for review, technical comments, recommendations for withdrawal, confirmation or maintenance.
- This information should be compiled and circulated as an INF document.
- A recommendation from the WG/MT responsible for the publication should be made at the meeting leading to a decision by the P-members.



Review and maintenance procedures: Recommended procedures ([AC/6/2010](#), [FAQ](#)) (cont.)

- When the decision is to confirm, then there is no need to issue the FormRR as the information will be minuted in the RM document.
- If the decision is to withdraw, then it is recommended always to issue the FormRR as other TC/SCs could be effected by the eventual withdrawal of a publication.
- Otherwise decisions will have to be made by correspondence.

Tools to take part in IEC work

- All tools available from IEC website: www.iec.ch
- Up-to-date information on all TC/SC projects
- Access to all IEC working documents
- Electronic voting / commenting
- Template for forms and drafting standards
- IEC Experts Management System (EMS)
- Collaboration tools
- Online registration for IEC TC/SC meetings
- Web-conferencing



Expert Management System (EMS): Improvements ([AC/24/2008](#), [AC/9/2009](#))

- Personal information: experts maintain own details (e-mail, address, telephone number)
- New e-mail notifications: personal changes – to relevant TC/SC officers and convenors
- Title: mandatory field limited to Mr, Mrs, Ms
- Statistics: experts by NC; experts by WG-MT
- Access to membership information: extended to WG/MT experts
- Extraction to Excel: committee titles and statistics included



Collaboration Tools Suite ([AC/37/2007](#))

- Upload and distribution of working documents, discussion forum, tasks and issues, E-mail notifications
- Current username and password required to access this service
- To be used within Working Groups, Project Teams, Maintenance Teams and other well-defined groups within one TC / SC
- To be used also for distributing documents at TC / SC meetings ([AC/30/2009](#))



IEC Meeting registration system

([AC/16/2009](#), [AC/7/2010](#))

- All future TC/SC meetings shall make use of this system
- Allows full management of TC/SC meetings:
 - registration of delegates
 - information concerning the meeting
 - management and allocation of meeting rooms
 - information concerning accommodation
 - a “check-in” function to manage attendance of delegates to the meeting
- Access by IEC username / password –
<http://meetings.iec.ch>
- Open 4 months to 2 weeks before meeting
- Guidance for use available on the IEC website.



Webconferencing facilities offered by the IEC ([AC/18/2010](#))

- Webconferencing facilities for use by WG/PT/MT
- Product being used - GoToMeeting
- Voice conferencing and sharing of desktop screens by participants (up to 15, including the host)
- Convenor to contact the responsible TO (preferred date and time, subject of the meeting, list of participants with e-mail addresses)



Webconferencing facilities offered by the IEC ([AC/18/2010](#)) (cont.)

- CO to schedule the meeting and send invitations to participants with link and information to connect to the meeting
- Participants to install a small piece of software (further information available at <http://gotomeeting.com>)
- Connection using VoIP (using a headset directly connected to your computer) or dial-in using a normal phone
- The host will initially run the meeting, but may pass control to other participants

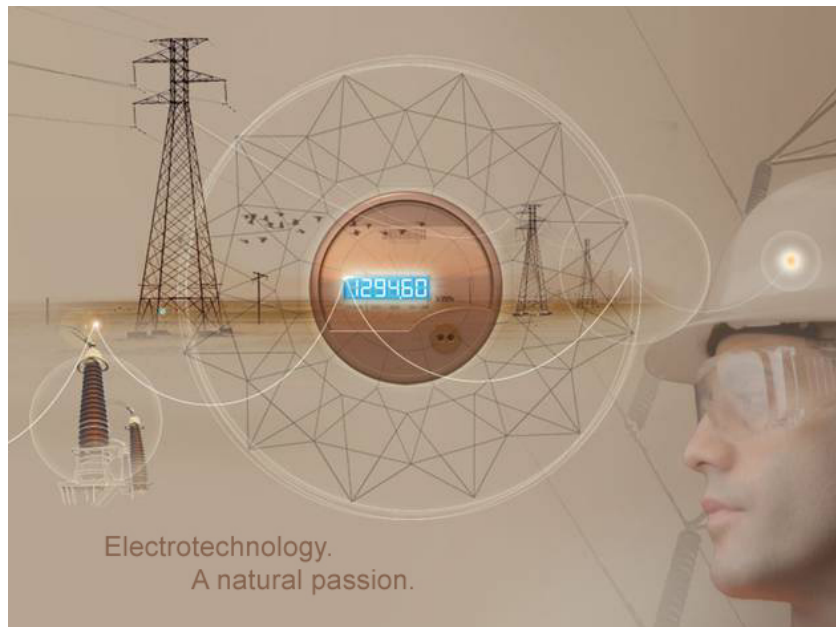
