BUREAU OF PRODUCT STANDARDS (BPS)

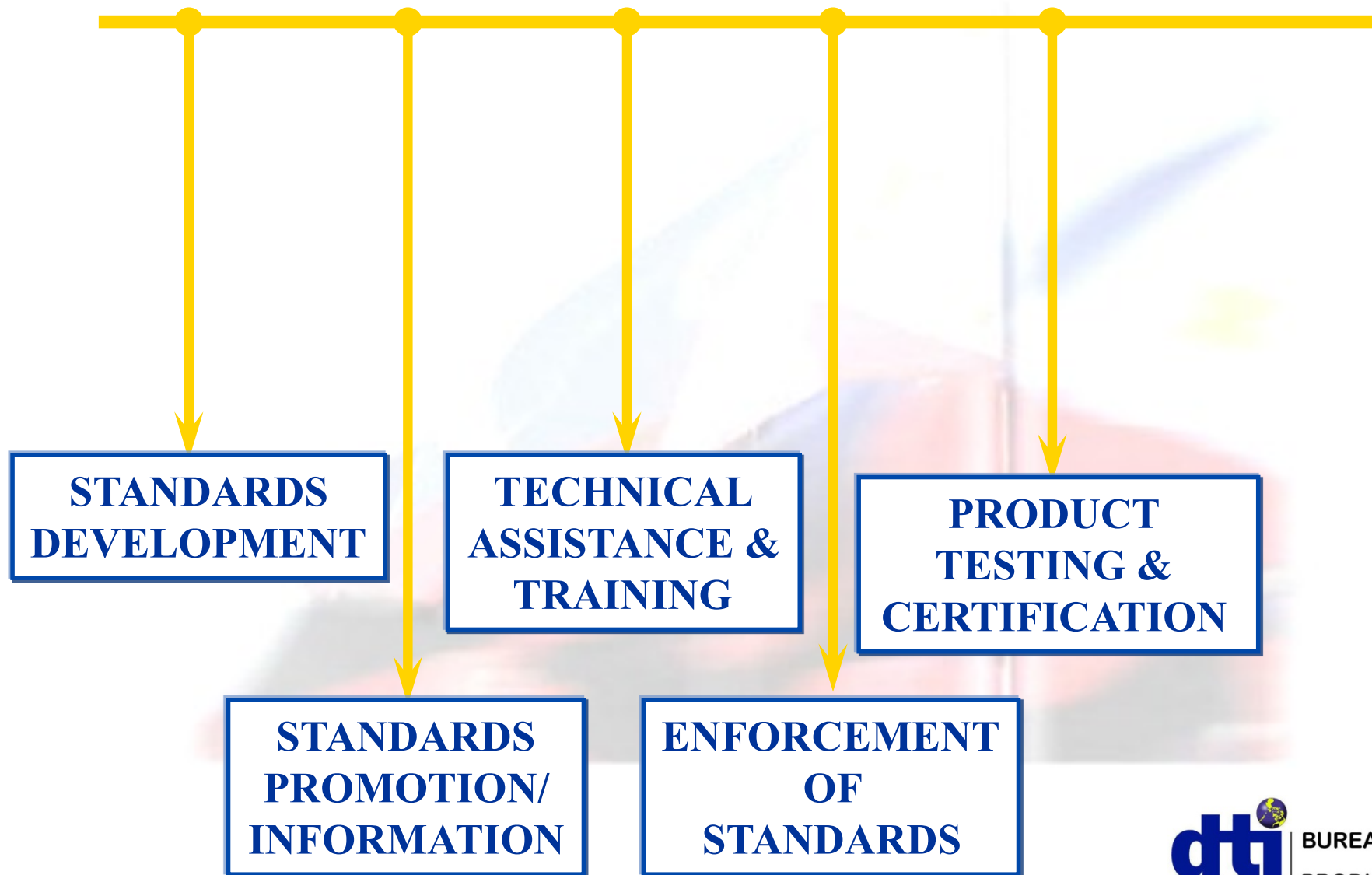
- An agency under the Department of Trade and Industry

Standards Development Procedures

BPS DIRECTIVES

The BPS Directives are issued as guides in the development of Philippine National Standard (PNS).

The objective in issuing these documents is to provide a clear understanding of technical work in the development of standards for smooth coordination among those involved as well as to facilitate the preparation of standards.



DEVELOPMENT OF PHILIPPINE NATIONAL STANDARDS

Preliminary Draft (New Work Item Proposal)

This maybe international standards or foreign standards, a draft submitted by an interested organization or individual, a draft prepared by the BPS

Committee Draft PNS (CDPNS)

This is the draft incorporating the decisions of the technical committee arising from deliberations of the Preliminary draft

Draft PNS (DPNS)

This is the draft which was approved by the technical committee for circulation for two months to stakeholders



DEVELOPMENT OF PHILIPPINE NATIONAL STANDARDS

Final Draft PNS (FDPNS)

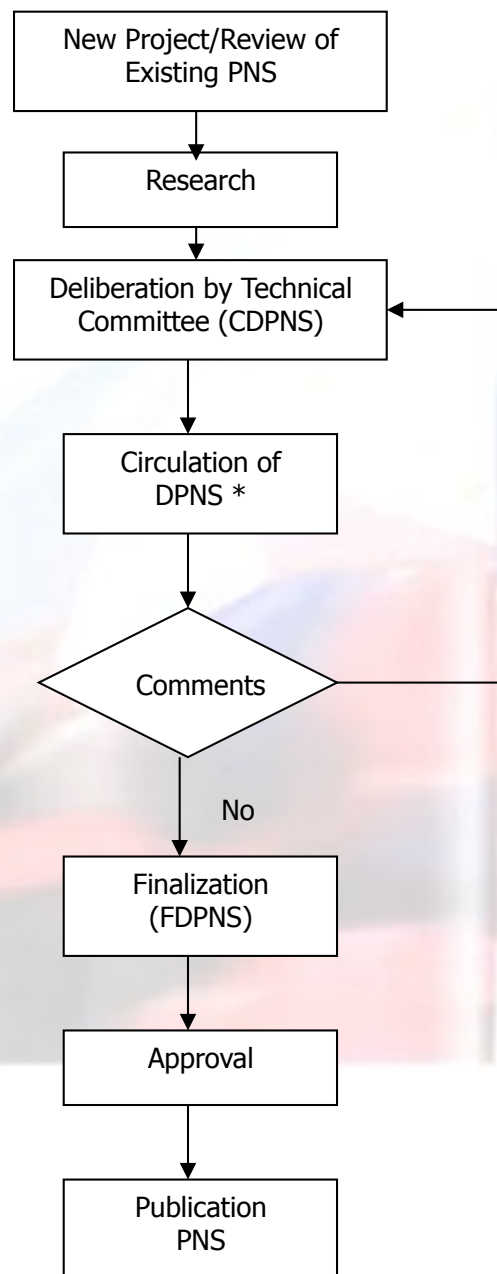
This is the draft incorporating all modifications, as a result of the technical committees study of the comments received during the circulation period

Philippine National Standard (PNS)

This standard shall be subjected to systematic review in order to determine whether it should be confirmed, amended/revised or withdrawn at least every five (5) years

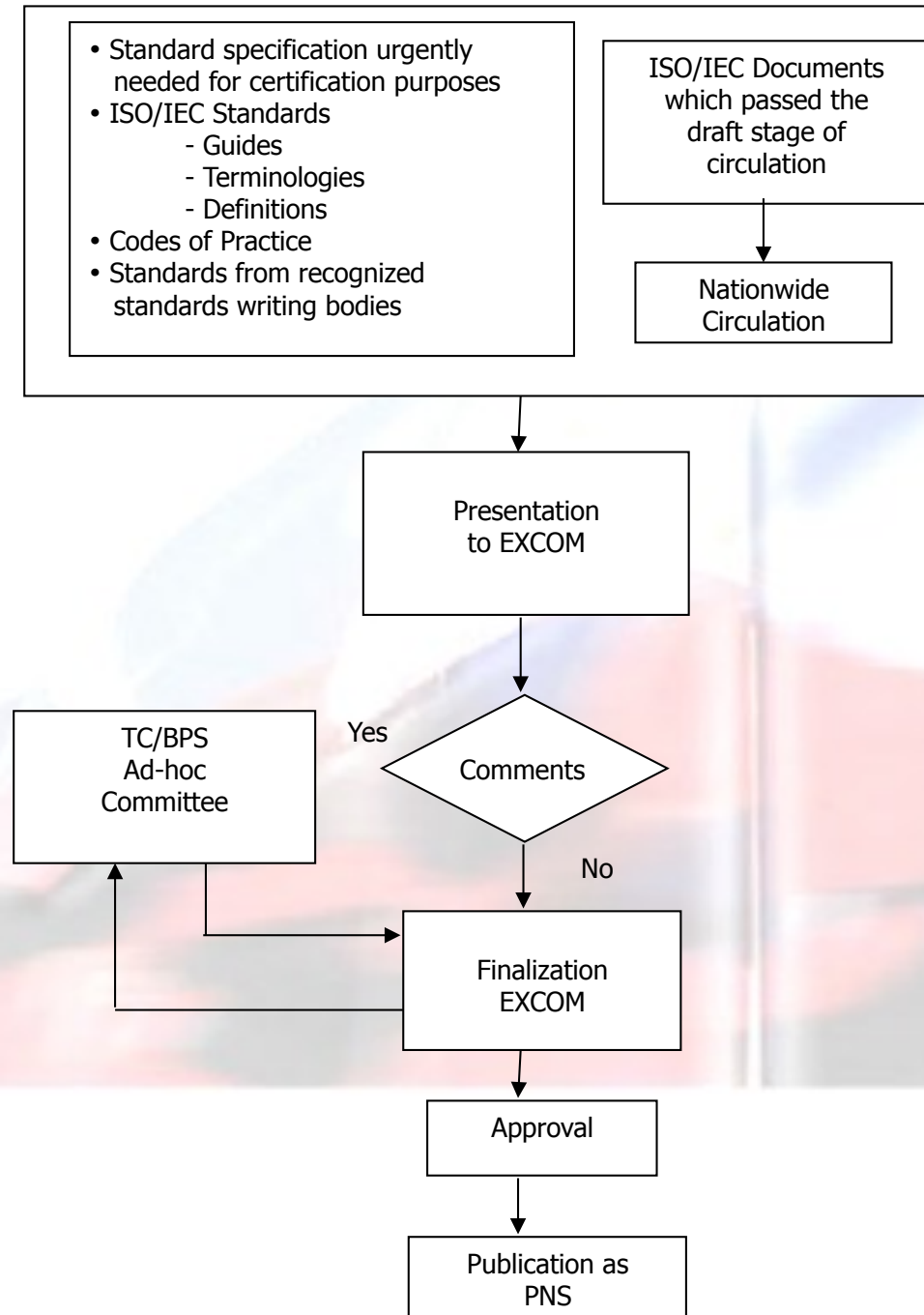


Technical Committee Method
